Our priority this summer is to give your child the best experience possible while following current CDC guidelines. Here is what you can expect for your student while they are participating in our summer internship.

1. We will maintain social distancing among staff and students (6 feet apart)
2. Students are asked to bring a face mask with them to the church. Students will be encouraged to wear their mask when in close proximity to peers/staff. Face masks will be optional when students are beyond the 6 foot social distance standard. *if you wish your student to wear a face mask throughout the day, please let us know.
3. We will encourage hand washing and the use of sanitizer throughout their time with us.
4. The church facility will be wiped down and sanitized after students occupy various church campus areas each day to ensure the health and safety of your student.

5. If your student develops a fever, cough or has been in contact with someone tested positive for covid-19, please keep them home and notify Pastor Evan.
